OF LIQUOR CONTROL ON THE ISSUANCE OF A C1 PERMIT  
TO THE LAWSON MILK COMPANY AT 712 COLUMBUS STREET

WHEREAS, a C1 Liquor Permit has been requested by the  
Lawson Milk Company for its store at 712 Columbus Street,  
Grove City, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, there are several churches within a short  
distance of 712 Columbus Street; and

WHEREAS, there is a city park, used for recreation purposes  
for persons of all ages, directly across the street from 712  
Columbus Street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Grove City objects  
to the issuance of a C1 permit to the business mentioned in the  
preamble of the resolution.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council forward a certified copy  
of this resolution to the Ohio Department of Liquor Control.

SECTION 3. This resolution is hereby declared an emergency  
measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
passage and the approval of the Mayor thereby preserving the  
public health, safety and welfare.






