

RESOLUTION No. CR-22-80

A RESOLUTION TO DISAPPROVE A NEW ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF APPORTIONMENT OF THE UNDIVIDED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUND OF FRANKLIN COUNTY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1981 AND BEYOND AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 5747.53 provides for an alternative method of apportionment of the undivided local government fund; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Franklin County, Ohio for each year since 1978, has been apportioning, and currently apportions, said fund according to an alternative method adopted and approved by a majority of the boards of trustees and legislative authorities of municipal corporations within Franklin County for 1978 and for all ensuing calendar years which alternative method has never been repealed; and

WHEREAS, a new alternative method of apportionment of the undivided local government fund of Franklin County has been proposed by the Franklin County Budget Commission on June 23, 1980 for the calendar year 1981 allocation and beyond for adoption approval; and

WHEREAS, it is the concensus of this council to support and endorse the present apportionment method as the most equitable means to allocate the Undivided Local Government Fund of Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, THE Franklin County Budget Commission has set a deadline of July 22, 1980 for adoption and approval of the new alternative method of apportionment, and it is necessary to act immediately upon this resolution in order to implement the new alternative method of apportionment, thereby preserving the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Grove City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Grove City hereby disapproves the Alternative Method of Apportionment of the Undivided Local Government Fund of Franklin County, Ohio as proposed by the Franklin County Budget Commission on June 23, 1980 and to serve notice of this intention through transmittal of a certified copy of this resolution to the secretary of the Franklin County Budget Commission on or before July 22, 1980.

SECTION 2. For reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof, this resolution is declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and the approval of the Mayor.






