

RESOLUTION NO. CR-34-78

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN
APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER
THE FEDERAL LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION ACT
FOR THE GANTZ FARM

WHEREAS, the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965 (Public Law 88-578) provides financial assistance to the State of Ohio for outdoor recreation purposes, and

WHEREAS, the City of Grove City desires financial assistance under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Grove City hereby approves filing an application for Land and Water Conservation Fund Act financial assistance.

SECTION 2. The Administrative Assistant is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Department of Natural Resources, State of Ohio, and to provide all information and documentation required in said application for submission to the Federal Bureau of Outdoor Recreation.

SECTION 3. The Council of the City of Grove City hereby does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and thus become eligible for Land and Water Conservation Fund Act financial aid of 50% of the actual allowable reimbursement cost.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




