

RESOLUTION NO. CR-36-09

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT FEDEX GROVE CITY OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the United States Senate is currently reviewing a 230-word provision in the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2009 which unfairly targets FedEx Express and could lead to job loss in the company; and

WHEREAS, Grove City is home to a large FedEx Ground Shipping Hub; and

WHEREAS, the Grove City Ground Shipping Hub employs over 1,000 people and provides revenue for local and state government; and

WHEREAS, FedEx Express employs more than 2,100 people in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, any legislation that affects FedEx Express will have an impact on the Grove City Ground Hub and the local economy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Council and the Administration hereby urges Senator George Voinovich and his colleagues in the U.S. Senate to oppose any language in the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2009 that would impact FedEx Express and our FedEx Group Shipping Hub.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to send a copy of this resolution to Senator George Voinovich, Senator Sherrod Brown, Representative Mary Jo Kilroy and FedEx President, Fred Smith.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


