

RESOLUTION CR-5-65

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING BOARD TO HEAR OBJECTIONS TO ESTIMATED ASSESSMENTS WITH RESPECT TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF HAUGHN ROAD, OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, BY THE GRADING, PAVING AND CONSTRUCTION OF CURB, GUTTER, DRAINAGE, SIDEWALK AND APPURTENANCES THERETO.

WHEREAS, this Council did, on the 4th day of January, 1965, duly adopt Resolution CR-1-65 declaring therein the necessity of improving Haughn Road, between Columbus Street and a point approximately 50' south of the intersection of the centerlines of Woodgrove Drive and Haughn Road, by installing a 30 foot wide pavement, including grading, concrete curbs, concrete sidewalks, drainage and miscellaneous appurtenant work; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution the estimated assessments for said improvement have been prepared and placed on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council; and

WHEREAS, notice of the passage of said resolution and of the filing of said estimated assessments has been duly served upon all property owners to be assessed in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, written objections to said estimated assessment have been filed by one or more such property owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that


SECTION 1. That Mr. Leslie Bostic, Mr. Gerald Ingram

and Mr. Eugene Walsh, three disinterested freeholders of said City be and the same hereby are appointed as an assessment equalization board to hear and determine all written objections filed in accordance with law to the estimated assessments heretofore filed with the Clerk of this Council pursuant to Resolution No. CR-1-65 of this Council. Said board is hereby authorized and directed to equalize such assessments as it deems proper to conform to the standards prescribed by said Resolution No. CR-1-65, and by law.

SECTION 2. Said assessment equalization board shall meet at 7:30 o'clock P.M., on the 22nd day of March, 1965, at the Municipal Building, for the purposes aforesaid, and upon completion of such hearing and any adjournments thereof, shall report its recommendations, including any changes which should be made in the estimated assessment, to this Council.

SECTION 3. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
