

RESOLUTION NO. CR-6-86

A RESOLUTION TO SET FORTH, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 709.031 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES THAT CAN BE FURNISHED TO A 0.459 ACRE TRACT, NORTH OF ANGLEBROOK DRIVE AND EAST OF DEMOREST ROAD IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP UPON ITS ANNEXATION TO GROVE CITY

WHEREAS, a petition to annex 0.459 acres east of Demorest Road, north of Anglebrook Drive in Jackson Township to the City of Grove City was signed by Kenneth E. Strickler, et al and was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, a hearing on this petition is scheduled before the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County on February 12, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Section 709.031 of the Ohio Revised Code requires that the municipal legislative authority of the municipality to which the annexation is proposed adopt a statement indicating what services, if any, the municipal corporation will provide to the territory proposed for annexation upon its annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Upon its annexation to the City of Grove City, the 0.459 acre tract west of Demorest Road, north of Anglebrook Drive proposed for annexation by Kenneth E. Strickler, et al will receive the following municipal services from the City of Grove City:

Fire: Jackson Township will continue to provide fire protection.

Police: Subject property is within the overall area now covered by the Grove City police cruisers.

Water: There is an existing water line on the west side of Demorest Road in front of the subject property.

Sanitary Sewers: There is no sanitary sewer line adjacent to subject property nor is any construction proposed which would make sanitary sewer service available in the near future.


Garbage and Refuse Collection: Subject property is now serviced by and would continue to be served by the same private collection service that now serves the incorporated area of Grove City.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




