

RESOLUTION NO. CR-7-66

Resolution confirming and approving the sale of \$66,449.52 City of Grove City Special Assessment Street Improvement Notes, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds.

WHEREAS, this Council did heretofore duly adopt Ordinance No. C-16-66, on February 24, 1966, authorizing the issuance and sale of \$66,449.52 Notes of the City of Grove City, Ohio, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments and in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of paying the property owner's share of the cost of improving Haughn Road and certain other designated streets within said City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Ordinance No. C-16-66, said notes have been offered to the officer in charge of the bond retirement fund for purchase for said fund at the par value and accrued interest, and said officer has declined to purchase said notes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said ordinance C-16-66, the Director of Finance is authorized to sell said notes at private sale for not less than the par value and accrued interest to date of delivery and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed four and one-half percentum ($4\frac{1}{2}\%$) per annum, payable at maturity; and

WHEREAS, The Huntington National Bank of Columbus, Columbus, Ohio, has offered to purchase said notes at the par value thereof plus a premium of \$33.25 and accrued interest to date of delivery, and bearing interest at the rate of three and one-fourth percentum ($3\frac{1}{4}\%$) per annum payable at maturity.
